

Watercolor & Ink ~ Cityscapes and Landscapes: Materials List

Bring the following materials to the first class.

- **2B pencil, eraser, black gel pen, drawing paper**

I will be going over the various pros and cons of different materials in the first class. If you want to wait until after this class to purchase supplies, that's fine. In the first class we will not be painting, only sketching with the pencil and pen.

Recommended Materials

Pens

- Black gel pen. I will be showing you the various pens I use in the first class and you can decide if you would like to use the same kind.

Watercolor

- Minimal color selection: warm & cool of each primary (red, yellow, blue) and black. I will bring my own watercolors and show you my palette. You can bring what you have and we can discuss your options.
- Gouache: Permanent White (Don't add this to the palette, but leave in tube.)

Brushes

- We will discuss the options in class. Bring what you have to see if they will work.

Paper

- Type: 140lb., cold press, watercolor paper. Spiral bound notebooks are best as they will lie flat when you open them up.
- Size: Any size from 6" x 9" up to 9" x 12". Don't get anything larger as you will need to be able to sit with it comfortably outside.
