I will be going over the various pros and cons of different types of pens in the first class. What I will demonstrate will be gel pens, ballpoint pens, micron pens, fountain pens, and dip pens. You do not need to use the type of pen I use for demonstrations, as this class focuses on ink techniques, rather than specific materials.

Materials List

2B Pencil and Eraser

Pens

- Bring whatever pen or pens you have. After the demonstrations you may choose to get different types, or work with what you already have.

Watercolor

- A small portable watercolor palette. Winsor and Newton have a good collection. I will bring my own watercolors and show you my palette.

Brushes

- Watercolor brushes (make sure you have at least one large round brush, #10 or #12) and water container
- Or waterbrushes (these are brushes that have the water contained in the handle/barrel of the brush)

Paper

- Type: 140lb., cold press, watercolor paper. Spiral bound notebooks are best as they will lie flat when you open them up.
- Size: 9" x 12" is a good size as it is easy to carry and big enough to create a detailed image.
