

**Sketching at the deYoung**  
Fridays, 1 – 4pm,  
12 sessions: 9/15 – 12/8 (no class 11/24)

At the first class, 9/15, we will meet in the front courtyard by the museum doors. For all the rest of the classes we will meet inside, on the first floor, at the many-sided wood bench in the center area.

**Materials List**

We are only allowed to use specific types of medium at the museum. Please just bring what is on this list.

- **HB, 2B, and 4B Pencils**
- **Colored Pencils**  
Yellow, Red, Blue, Violet, Brown and White at the minimum.
- **Hand Held Sharpener**  
Bring a small container with a lid to hold the pencil shavings
- **Kneaded Eraser**
- **Hard All-Purpose Eraser**
- **Stomp or Tortillion**
- **9" x 12" or 8" x 10" Pad of Good Drawing Paper**  
Do not bring a larger pad, as this is prohibited, and do not bring a smaller one, as it will be difficult to put all the information down on it. Don't bring a "sketching" or "mixed media" pad. These will not take dry medium as well as drawing paper. I recommend you get a spiral bound pad, as they are easier to open and lay flat, without the pages coming out, when working.
- **Small Clip-On Lamp**  
The kind that you can clip onto a book and read by. You will definitely need this item.
- **Portable Stool**  
Make sure it is sturdy, yet small enough to easily carry around. Or you can borrow a very sturdy and comfortable stool from the museum for the afternoon.
- **Optional: Conte' Pencils**  
Blacks, Sanguine, Sanguine Medicis, White

Do not bring any rolling carts or large, armchair type of stools. You will be asked to leave these kinds of items at the coat check room by the museum staff.
