

# Acrylic Painting: The Fundamentals

## Materials List

At the first class we will be discussing various materials and their characteristics. If you already have acrylic paints and/or brushes bring what you have to the first class. If you buy acrylic paints get the following 8 colors. This palette contains a cool and warm of each of the primary colors, plus Payne's Gray and Titanium White.

### Paint

- Ultramarine Blue
- Cerulean Blue Hue or Phthalo Blue Green Shade
- Permanent Rose or Quinacridone Magenta
- Cadmium Red or Naphthol Red or Pyrrole Red
- Hansa Yellow
- Cadmium Yellow or Primrose Yellow
- Payne's Gray
- Titanium White

### Brushes

Synthetic or natural hair brushes that are designed for acrylic painting. Do not bring hog bristle brushes, which are very stiff. Do not bring cheap brushes, as you will not be able to get satisfactory results.

- **1" flat brush**
- **½" inch flat**
- **#10 or #12 round**

### Palette

Either a disposable palette or Masterson Sta-Wet palette (This is what I use)

### Strathmore Acrylic Paper pad, 246lb., 9" x 12"

- Do not bring any other type of paper. Other brands are much lighter weight and will not work as well.

### Matte Medium for Acrylics and small container with lid

Get the liquid form, not paste

### Slow Drying Medium for Acrylics and small container with lid

### 2B pencil and eraser

### Water container

### Rags and paper towels
