

Intermediate Watercolor with Carlo Grunfeld

Minimally Required Materials for

1. Pencils and/or pens for sketching
2. Watercolor paints
8 tubes, 5 or 7.5 ml size
yellow: Hansa Yellow Deep (Utrecht) **or** Winsor Yellow (Winsor & Newton) **or** Cadmium Yellow
yellow: Lemon Yellow
red: Cadmium Red, **or** Permanent Red (Holbein), **or** Winsor Red
red: Alizarin Crimson
blue: Ultramarine Blue **or** Winsor Blue/red shade
blue: Winsor Blue/green shade **or** Manganese Blue **or** Cobalt Blue
Sepia **or** Burnt Umber
Payne's Gray **or** Indigo
Student-grade colors are fine as long as they are similar to those listed.
3. Watercolor brushes
four:
3/4 inch-wide flat **and** #14 round **and** smaller brush for details such as #8 red sable
and wider flat brush, up to 1 1/2 inches
Any quality will do
4. Watercolor paper
Any 9" x 12" pad, 140 lb.
You may get a larger pad or sheets of 140 lb. paper and cut it up for smaller sizes.
5. Large-size covered palette

Optional:

Masking fluid and an inexpensive medium round brush to apply

Please bring in addition to the above any usual watercolor materials that you own and think would be useful.
