

Sketching at the deYoung Museum  
Sketching at the Legion of Honor Museum

At the deYoung Museum we will meet in the main hall across from the bookstore, at the wood benches, which will be in the center of the hall or against the stairway wall.

At the Legion of Honor Museum we will meet in the central entryway just past the ticket counters.

Please be on time, as I cannot guarantee which gallery we will be sketching in until we get to the museum. Exhibits can change during the week, or a large group can be having a tour, so I have to make a final decision about where we will sketch at the time of the class.

### **Materials List**

We are only allowed to use specific types of medium at the museum. Please bring only what is on this list.

- HB, 2B, and 4B Graphite Pencils

- Colored Pencils: Yellow, Red, Blue, Violet, Orange, Green, Brown and White at the minimum

- Hand Held Sharpener

Bring a small container with a lid to hold the pencil shavings

- Kneaded Eraser

- Hard All-Purpose Eraser

- Stomp or Tortillion

- 9" x 12" or 8" x 10" Pad of Good Drawing Paper

Do not bring a larger pad, as this is prohibited, and do not bring a smaller one, as it will be difficult to put all the information down on it. Don't bring "sketching" or "mixed media" pad. These will not take dry medium as well as drawing paper. I recommend you get a spiral bound pad, as they are easier to open and lay flat, without the pages coming out, when working.

- Small Clip-On Lamp

Bring the kind that you can clip onto a book and read by. **You will definitely need this item.**

- Portable Stool

Make sure it is sturdy, yet small enough to easily carry around. Do not bring one with arms, as this is considered a chair and are not allowed. You can also borrow a very sturdy and comfortable stool from the museum for the afternoon.
