THE BLACK BOOK: EXPLORATIONS IN SKETCHBOOKING & JOURNALING

Required Materials for Students:

- A hardbound & stitched black sketchbook (ideally the 8 ¾" x 11 ¼" size) available at any art supply store.
- An X-acto blade holder and a #11 blade.
- Two inkjet prints of pictures of yourself (sizes not to exceed 4x6 or 5x7 inches) one of yourself as a kid and one as you are now. Preferably head shots that will be good for drawing exercises.
- A selection of colored pencils, such as Prismacolors.
- Graphite pencil (HB hardness) or you may like my favorites: Derwent water-soluble graphite in Dark, Medium, and Light Wash.
- A steel nib cartridge pen such as those made by Rotring and at least one chisel-shaped felt tip Calligraphic marker (ZIG Memory System and Itoya Doubleheader CL-10 have worked well for me). We are using ink, but basically staying in the range of what would be called *dry media*.
- Optional (but highly recommended) a Westcott Flexible Stainless Steel Ruler (12") with a cork backing.
- I will supply (X) number of sheets of dry transfer adhesive for a \$5.00 materials fee.
